- A determination to attend all training and most calls and to remain on the scene of the emergency until relieved by an Officer.
- A determination to always do your best, recognizing your moral and legal obligation to do so.
- A willingness to conduct yourself in a professional manner at all calls and events and to treat members of the public with courtesy and respect.
- A determination to always act in a safe manner and to promote safety within the department.
