

OUTDOOR RINK RULES AND BEHAVIOUR

- It is strongly recommended that all skaters wear CSA approved helmets during skating sessions.
- All participants must wear skates while on the ice surface.
- Children must be supervised
- Use of alcohol is prohibited

The following are not permitted on the ice at any time:

- Carrying children on the ice (including baby carriers).
- Use of headsets, cell phones or hand-held electronic devices on the ice
- Food and drinks.
- Rough play, speed and figure skating and multiplayer games (i.e., Tag and races), foul language or inappropriate behaviour.
- Throwing snowballs.

Wheelchairs and Skating Aids

- Only approved skating aids are allowed on the ice during skating.
- Chairs, sleds, strollers, and pylons <u>are not</u> permitted on the ice surface during public skating sessions.
- Wheelchairs are permitted during skating sessions.
- Wheels must be cleaned of sand and salt prior to entering the ice surface to ensure the safety of skaters.
- Wheelchair users are asked to use the perimeter of the ice closest to the boards.
