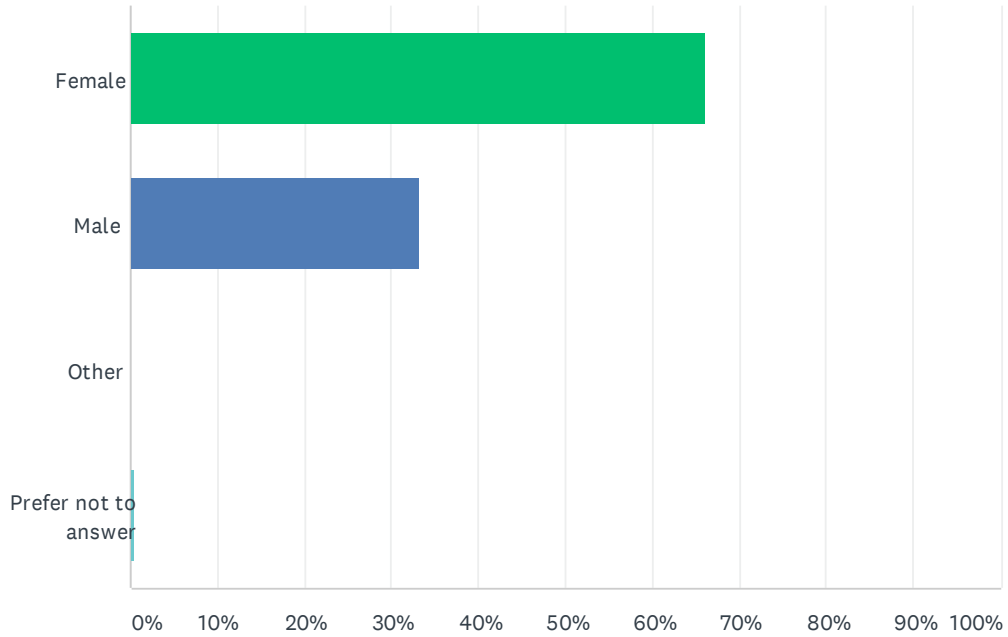


## Q1 What is your gender?

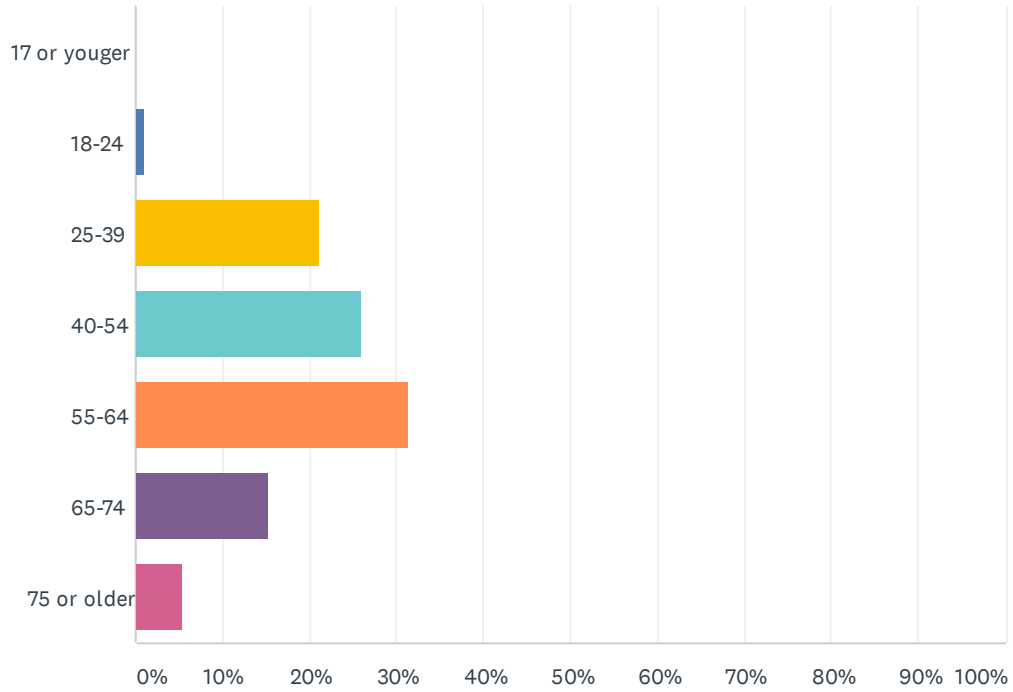

## Q2 How old are you?

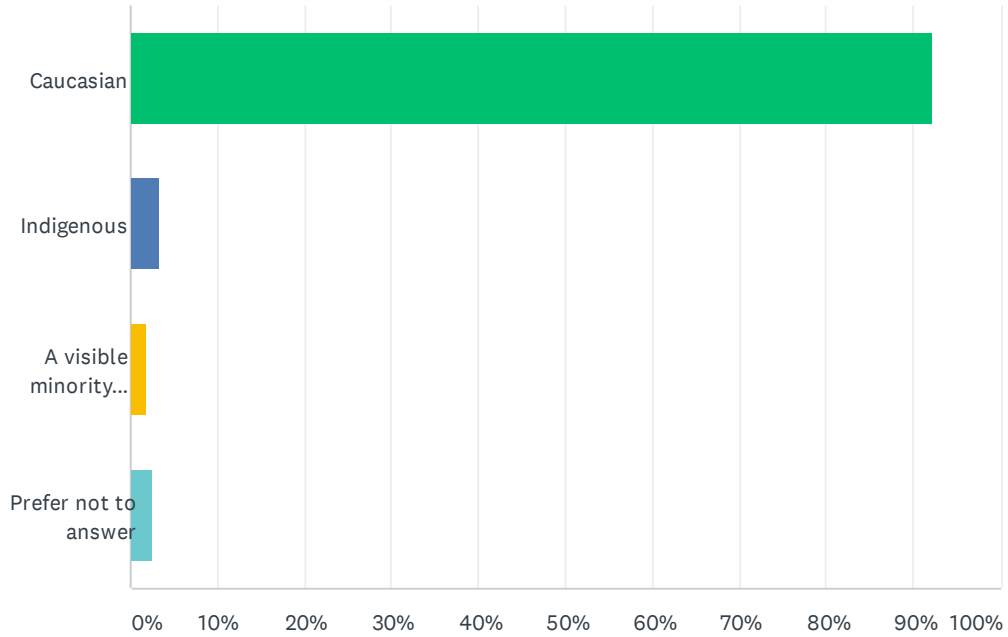

### Q3 How do you identify your race?

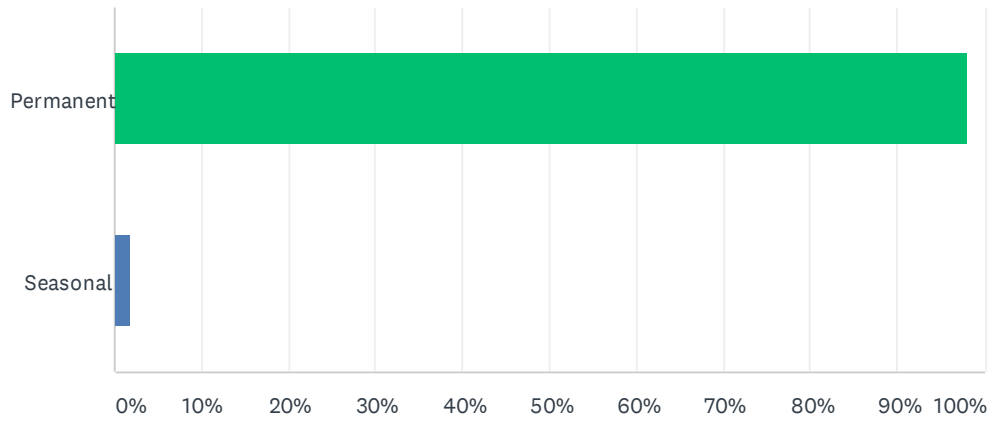

## Q4 Are you a permanent or seasonal resident?

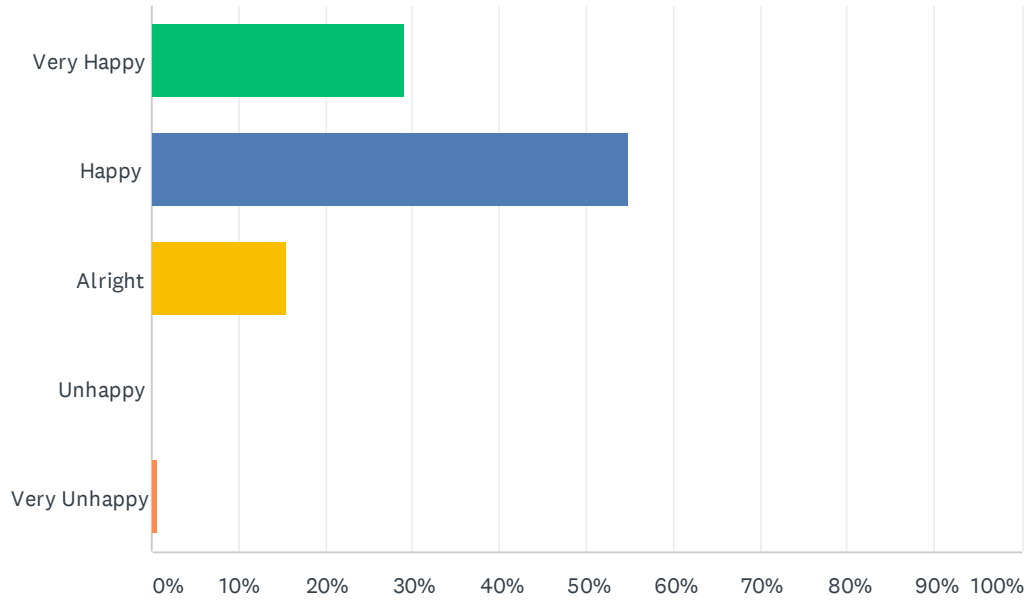

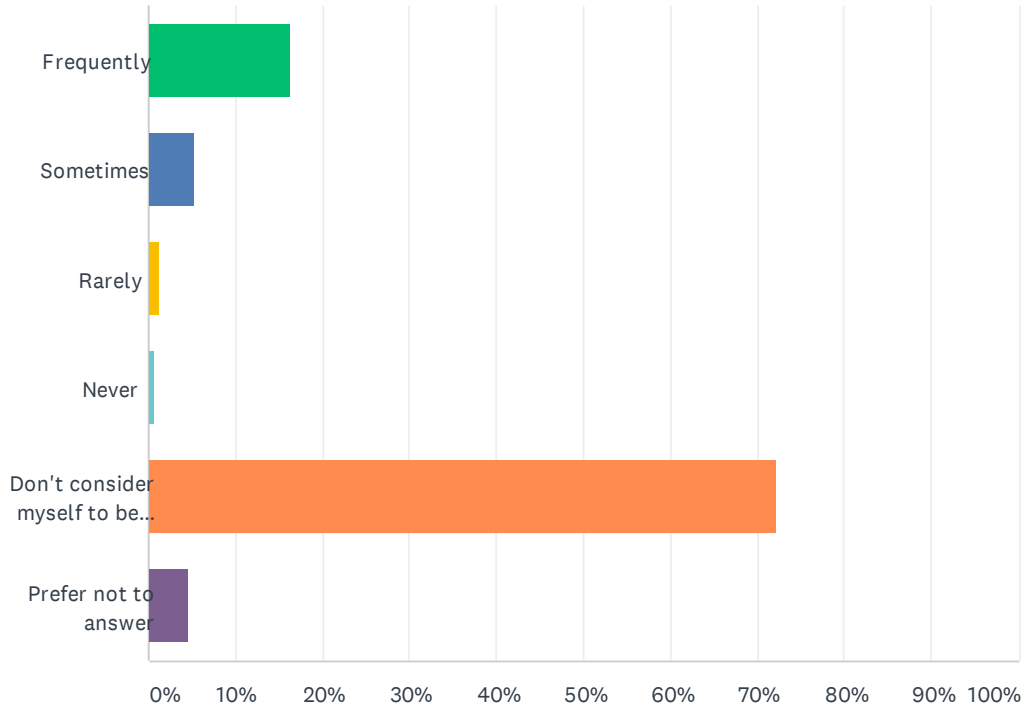

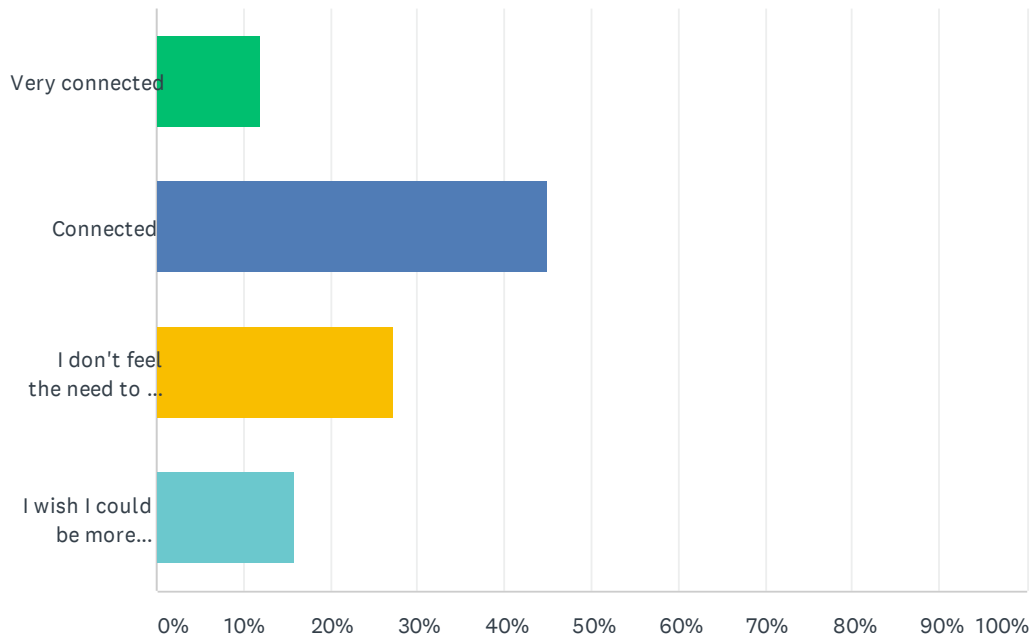

## Q8 Do you feel that you have a spiritual, religious or social connectedness with your community?

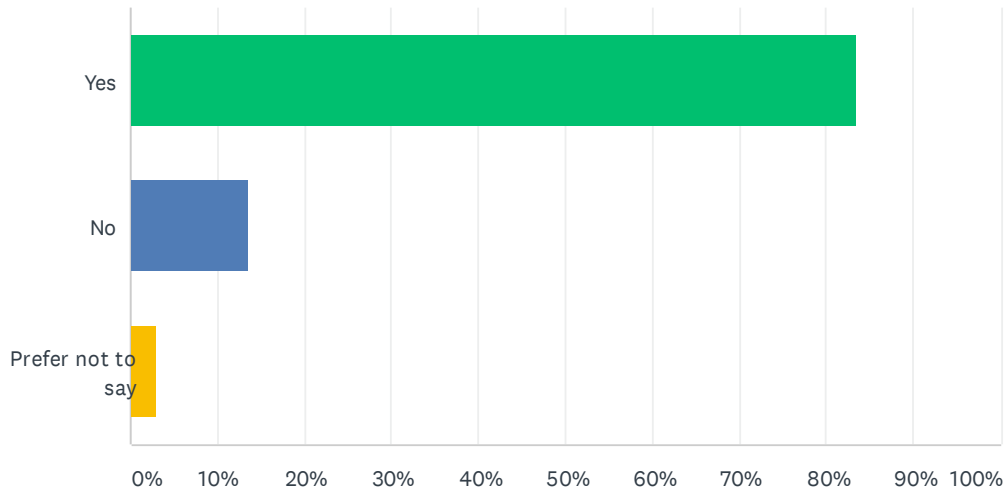

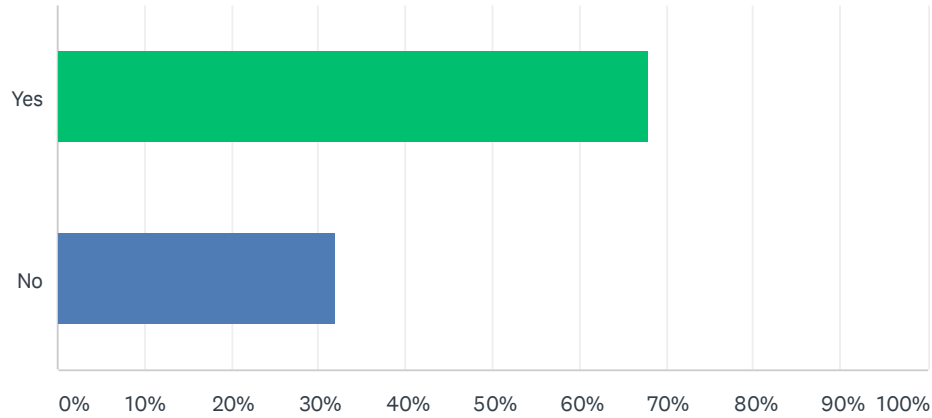

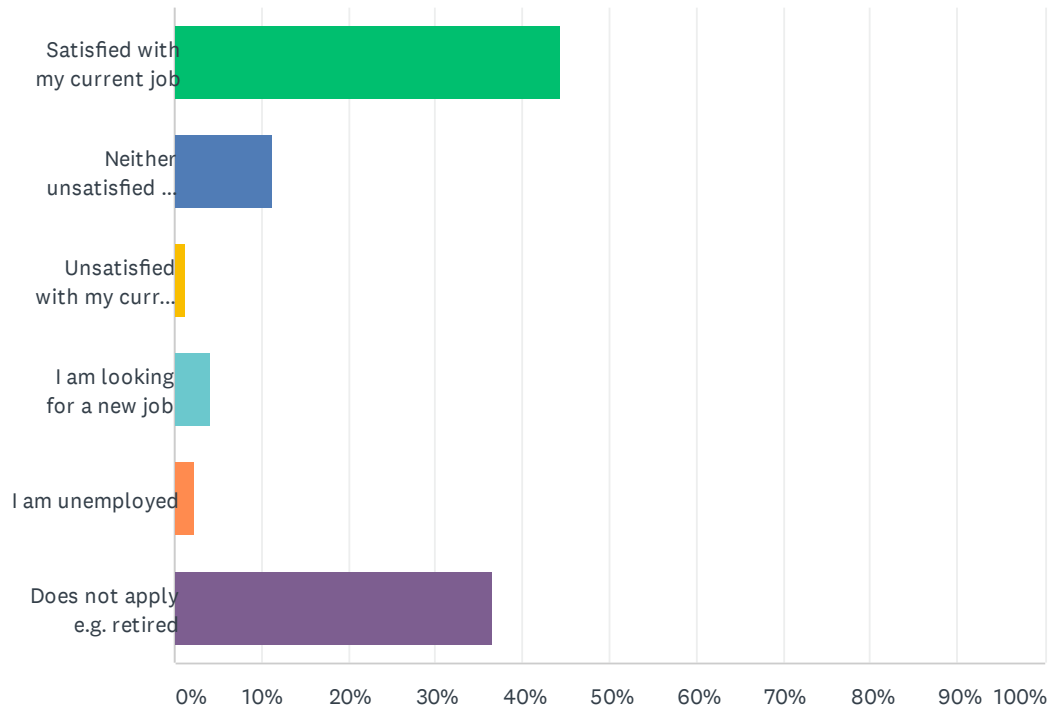

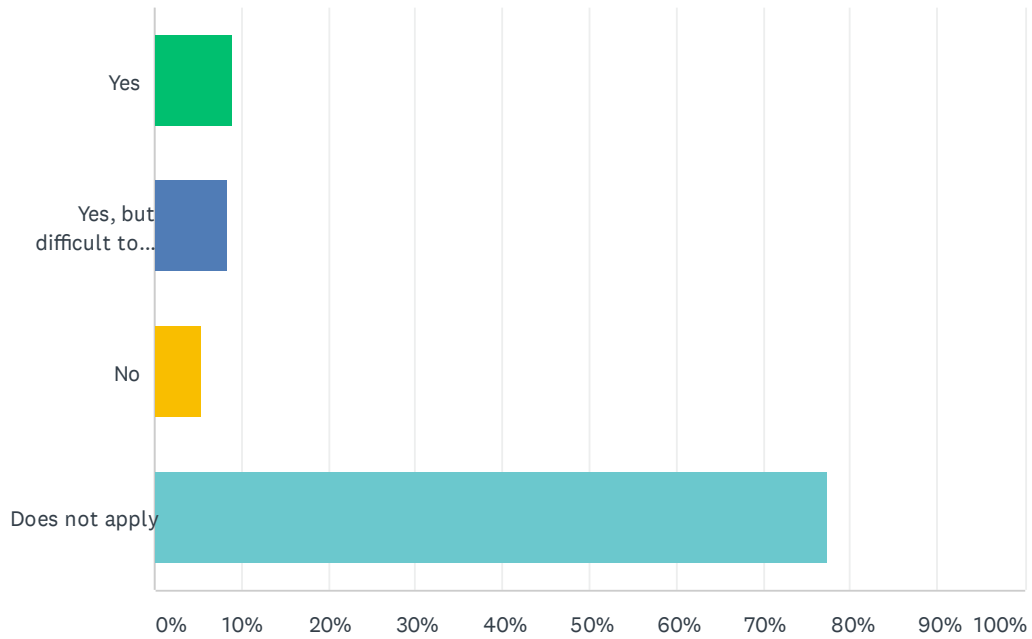

## Q23 My family has access to childcare / daycare services.

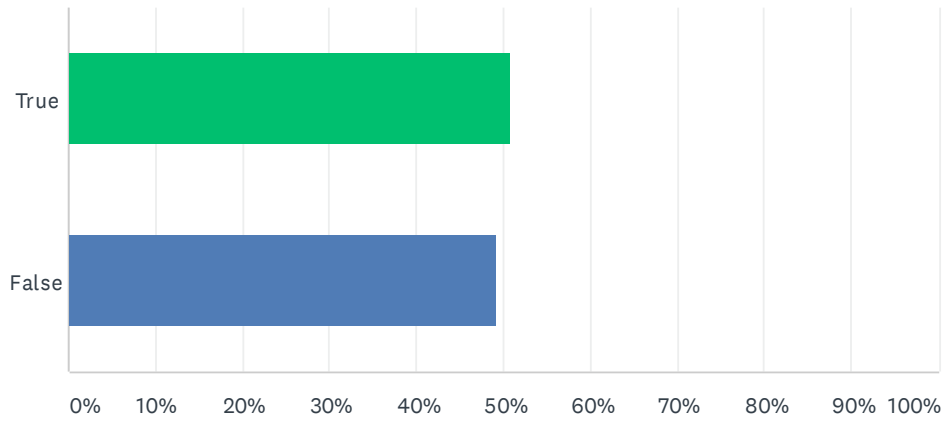

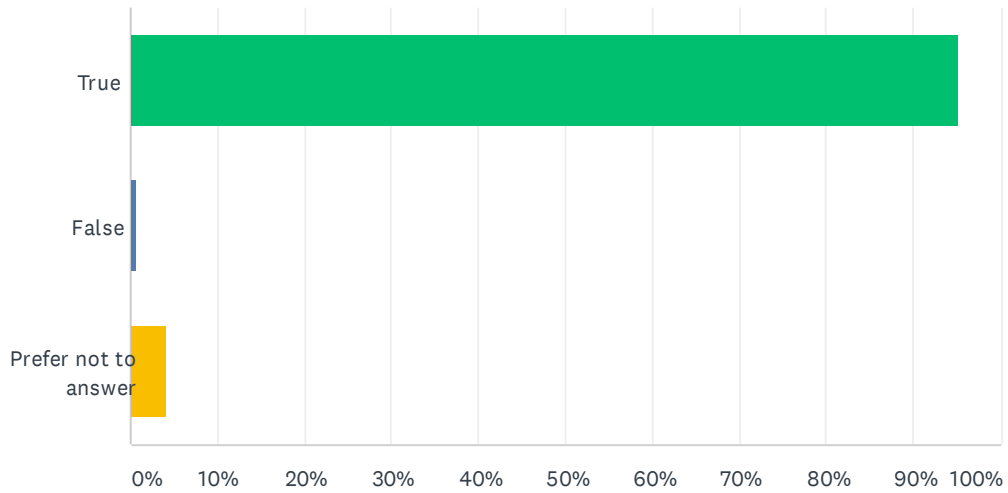

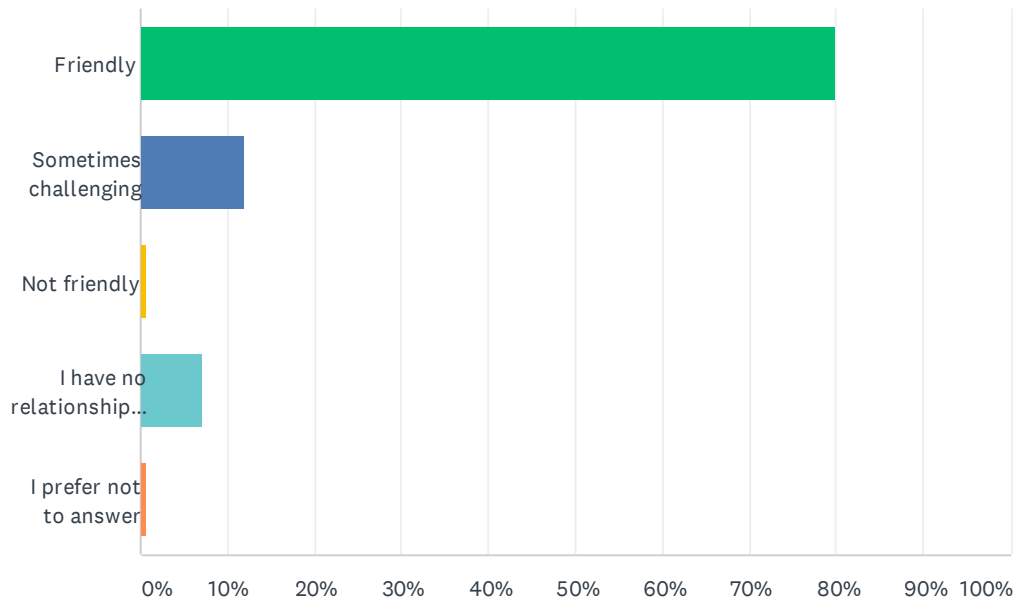

## Q28 How would you describe your relationship with your neighbors, not just the adjacent house, but in general those in your neighborhood?

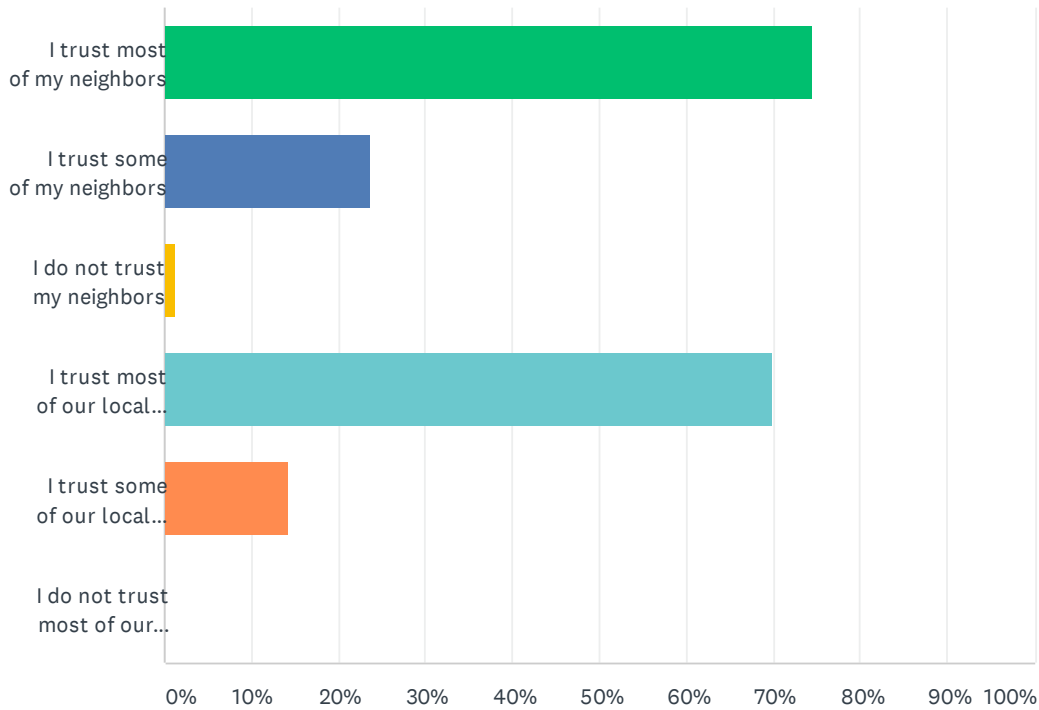

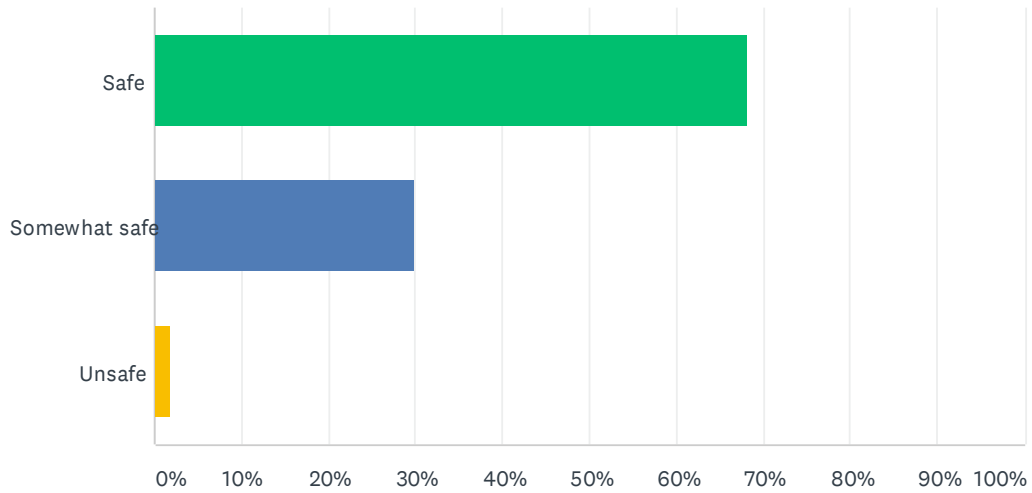

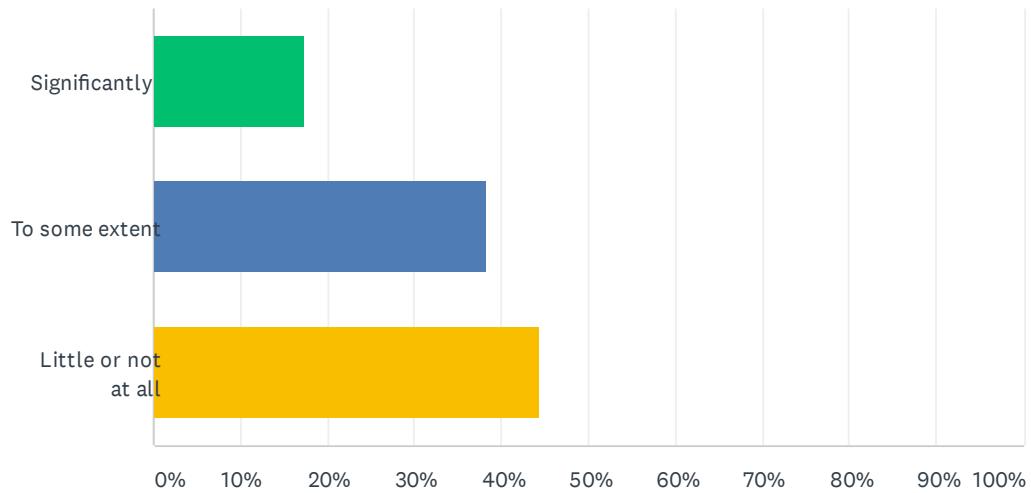

### Q34 How much does community safety influence your day-to-day activities?

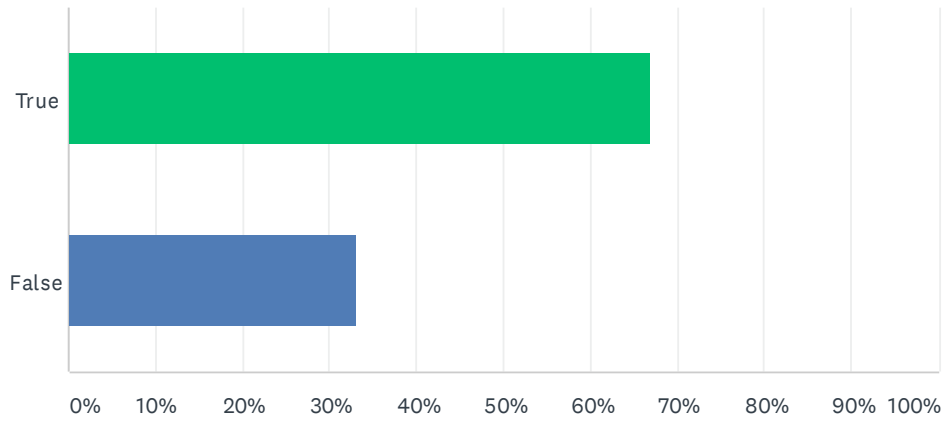

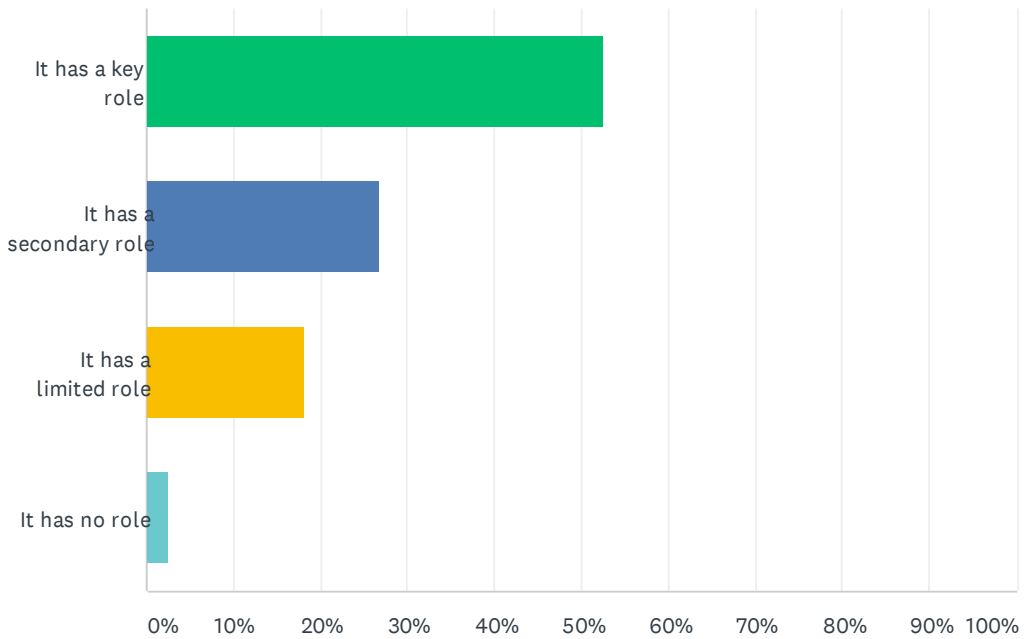

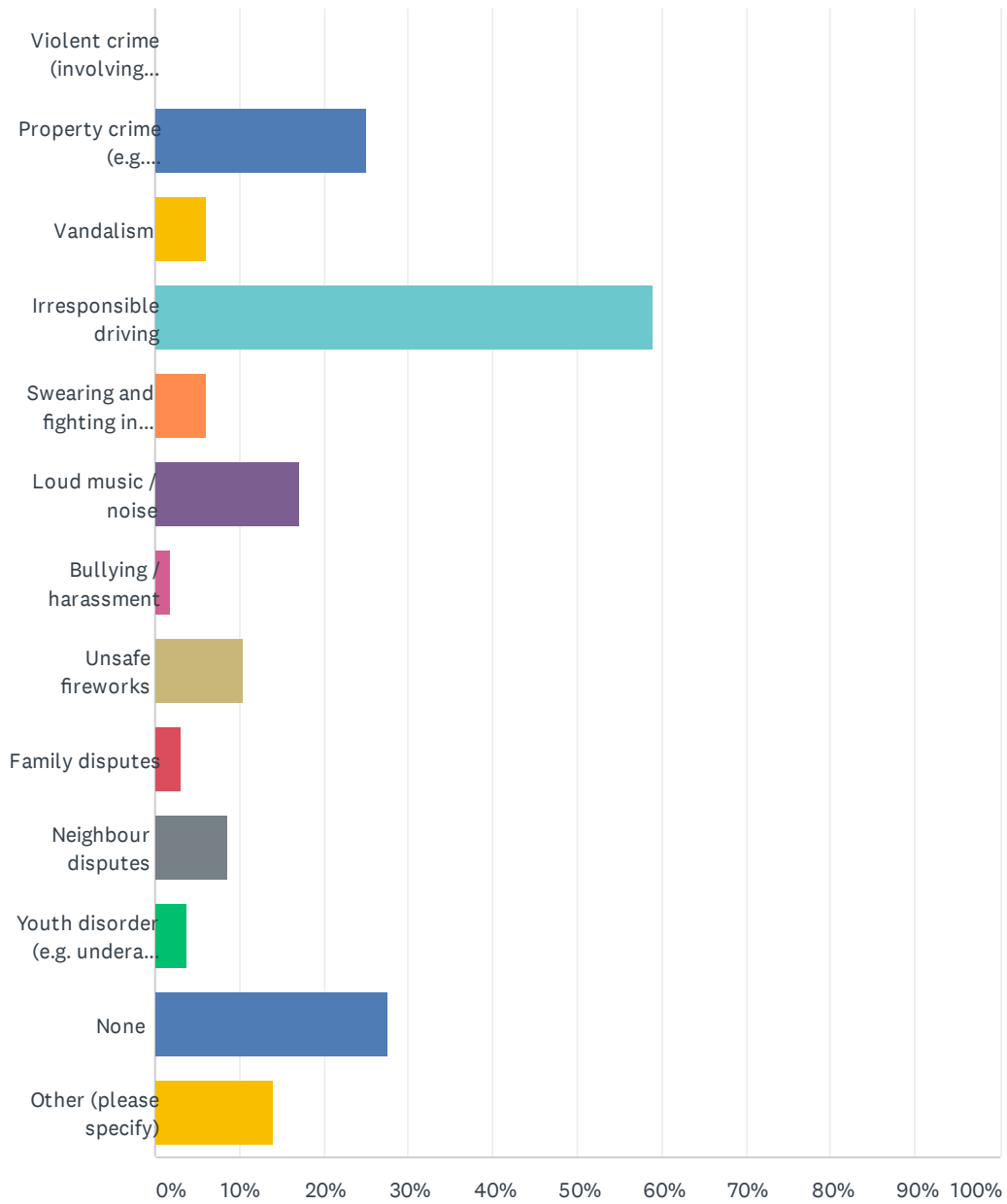

## Q45 Do you believe that the use of illicit drugs is an issue in our community?

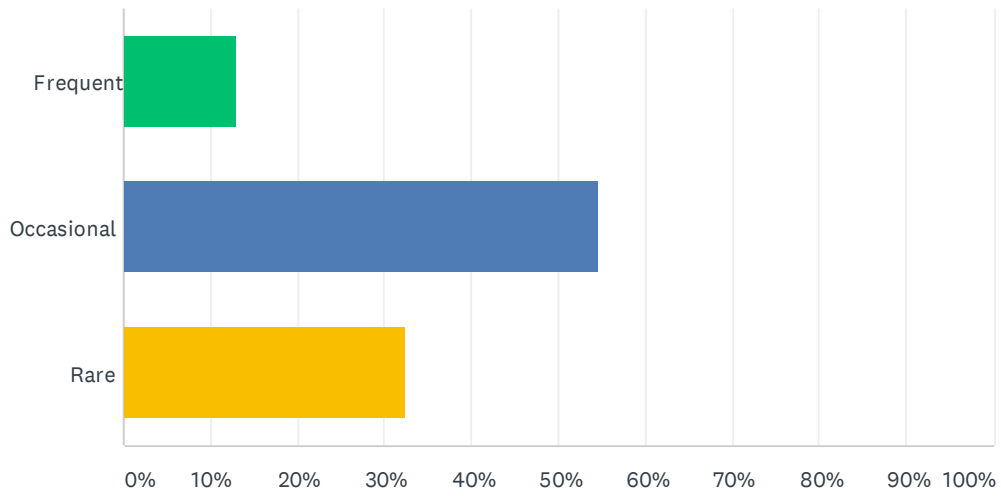

## Q46 How would you describe the level of illicit drug abuse in our community?

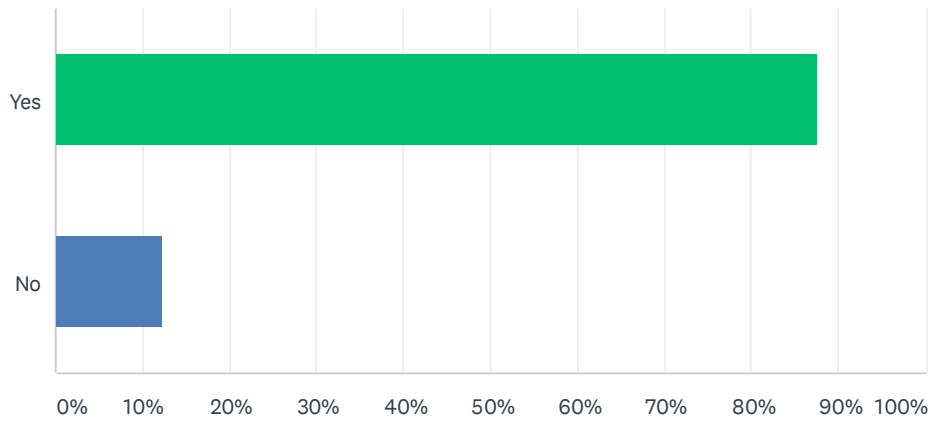

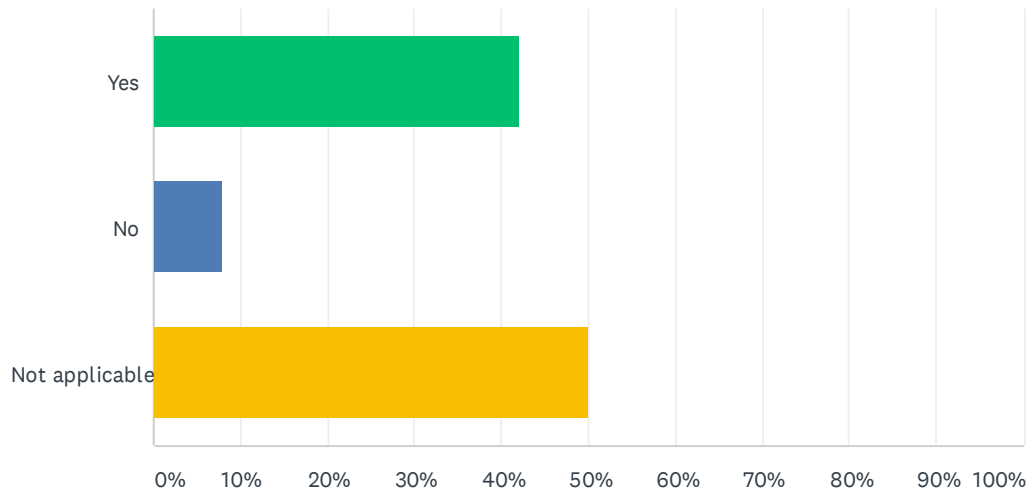

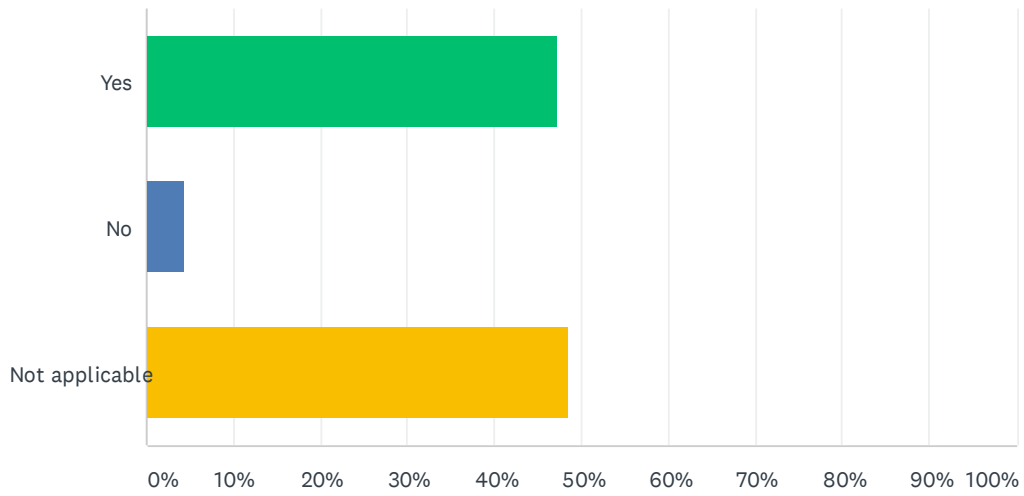

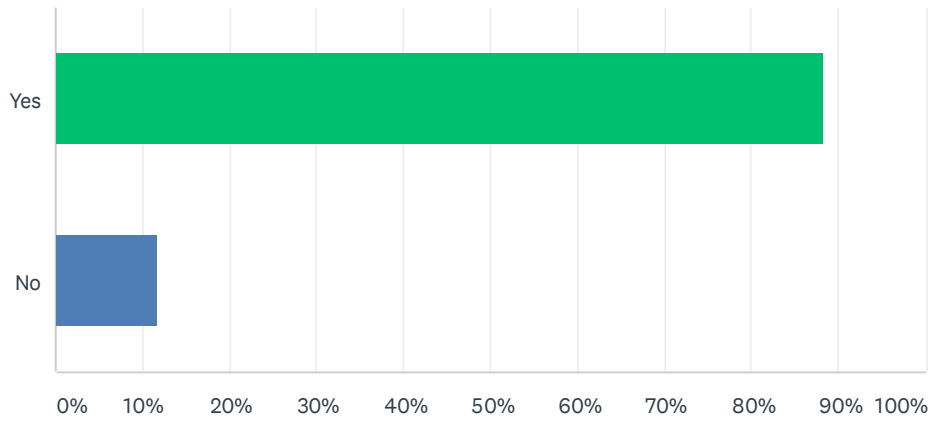

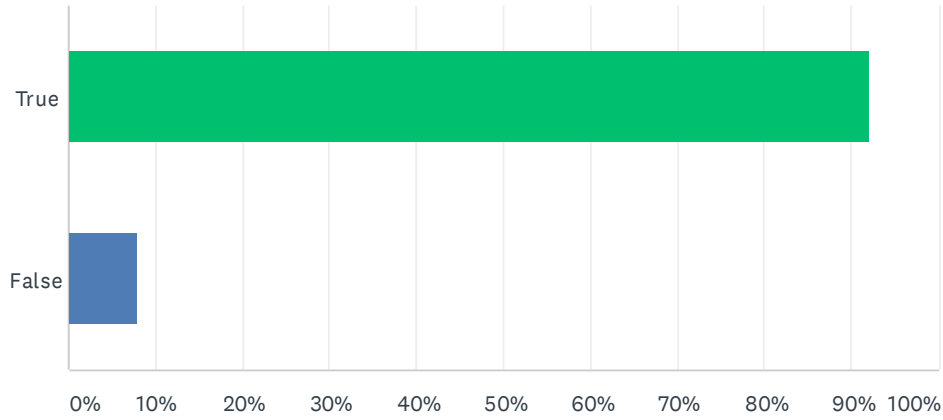
