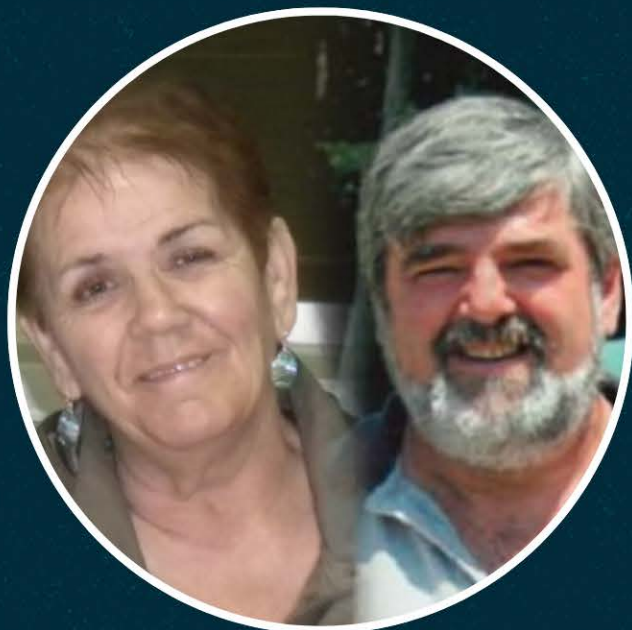


KAREN & RAYMOND SABOURIN

Karen and Raymond Sabourin were inducted into the East Ferris Sports Hall of Fame in the Builder category in recognition of their decades of volunteer leadership and fundraising dedication to youth sports and community recreation.

From 1985 to 2005, Karen and Ray served on the Minor Hockey Sports Committee, working tirelessly to ensure financial barriers never prevented local children from participating in sport. Their commitment extended to the East Ferris Winter Carnival, where they played key roles in organizing hockey events, recruiting volunteers and managing canteen operations.

Ray contributed extensively as a minor hockey coach at all levels, a local referee for over 30 years, founder of the Men's Junior Hockey League and Referee-in-Chief for men's hockey. These represent just a few of his many achievements. In 1991, both Karen and Ray were recognized by the Canadian Amateur Hockey Association (C.A.H.A.) for their dedicated service to minor hockey.

Together, Karen and Ray supported slow-pitch baseball in East Ferris by fundraising for field upgrades in Corbeil and Astorville.

Finally, Karen and Ray helped raise funds to send local youth to provincial competitions in archery, creating opportunities for many young archery athletes. Their shared passion for inclusion and youth development left a legacy in East Ferris.
